



Tool Setup

Depending on the guide module(s) installed on the daughtercard assembly, this tool can be used with dual-guide, left-guide, or right-guide options. There is a "dummy block" that can be installed on the side of the tool that does not engage a guide module. For dual-guide assemblies, the dummy block is reversed and stored on the outside of the tool.

Use a 2.5mm hex key to remove the M3 screw holding the dummy block. See Figure 1.





Tool Operation

1. Carefully place the alignment tool over the front of the daughtercard. See Figure 2.



- 2. With the tool on the daughtercard, locate the daughtercard on the PCB so its compliant tails are starting in the PCB holes.
- 3. Using insertion tool 62202-2008 or other suitable tool, press the daughtercard into the PCB (see document ATS-622022008). It is important that the alignment tool stays on the daughtercard during the press-in process. See Figure 3.
- 4. Remove the alignment tool from the daughtercard.



CAUTION: To prevent injury, never operate any press without the guards in place. Refer to the press manufacturer's instruction manual.

CAUTION: Molex application tooling specifications are valid only when used with Molex connectors and tooling.
